Dear Sleepless,

Your problem is a common one for many students around the world.

Here are some tips to help you deal with the stress. Good luck!

Make a study schedule for yourself, but don't study too much in one day. You remember more by studying one hour each day for six days, than six hours in one day. Also, don't study late at night (we often forget information studied then).

You learn best when you study in two-hour blocks. Every two hours, take a break for 15 to 20 minutes. Go outside and walk. Exercise is a great way to reduce stress.

Don't eat a lot of sugar or drink a lot of caffeine. Eat foods high in vitamin B (for example, eggs, yogurt, green vegetables, tofu, and rice). These give you energy and help you think more clearly.

A study partner can help you practice for the test. When you're worried about the exam, you can talk to your partner. This can reduce stress, too.

Mr. Drake, a website designer, has been designing websites for both local and international firms for the past ten years. He has also worked with schools on their websites. Below, he writes about the fundamentals of website designs.

Searching for information on the Internet often takes us to different websites. As we scroll through the pages, we notice that it is easier to obtain the information we want on some websites than others. There are several reasons for this.

One reason is the design of the webpage. Designs that are too elaborate serve to confuse and annoy users, especially if they do not serve a purpose. For example, a row of boxes in the middle of the webpage that do not serve as hyperlinks and are purely decorative can frustrate users when they realize they cannot click on the boxes to direct them to the information they need.

Another reason is many designers overlook language, spelling and grammatical errors. This is unprofessional and the information on the website may be deemed unreliable when such mistakes are rampant.

Interestingly, the content of the website can make it hard to obtain information. Many websites are guilty of providing irrelevant information on the homepage. Due to the lack of space, the most important information should be concise and placed on the homepage of the website, with links to other pages. Hence it is important to decide which information should be placed on the homepage. To do this, some creators place the most interesting or useful information to draw readers to the website.

Designing a website is simple enough, but designing a good website takes time and the process is fulfilling. Be clear what your website is about and who your users are. Then, you will be able to create one that is useful and interesting, and that keeps users coming back.
